The May Program is Dyeing of Cellulose Fibers. It will be presented by Nancy Russell. It is an overview of the process of Dyeing yarns and Roving.

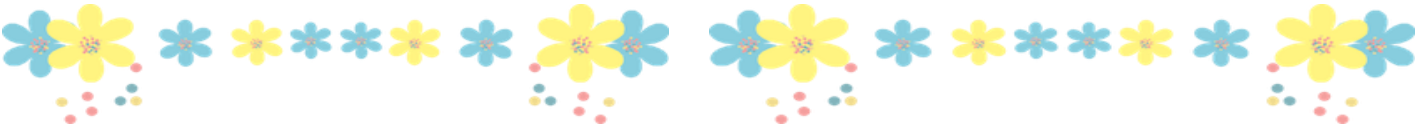
