

THE SCARF IS WOVEN FROM HANDSPUN WOOL/ SILK/RABBIT HAIR YARN GIVEN TO ME BY ONE OF MY WEAVING STUDENTS. IT WOULD PROBABLY BE CATEGORIZED AS "BULKY" KNITTING YARN. I WOVE IT IN THE WARP ON MY BABY WOLF 4-SHAFT LOOM AT 7 INCHES WIDE, SET AT 6 ENDS PER INCH. IT WAS SUCH A TIGHT FIT GOING THROUGH THE METAL HEDDLES OF MY LOOM THAT I HAD TO PULL IT (GENTLY BUT FIRMLY) WITH BOTH HANDS WHEN **ADVANCING. IT'S VERY THICK, SOFT AND WARM** AND I LOVE THE VARIETY OF FLEECE COLORS, FROM OFF-WHITE TO GRAY AND DARK BROWN. THE WEFT IS 3 STRANDS OF 10/2 TENCEL AND BAMBOO RAYON IN DIFFERENT SHADES OF BROWN.






PLAIN WEAVE NAPKINS IN 10/2






